On December 1, 1990, the Harbour Light of the Windwards began broadcasting the Word of God via a 5000 watt AM transmitter to the Windward Islands of the southern Caribbean. Seven years later, the station began FM broadcasts. Approximately 2.5 million people can regularly hear the programming through conventional radio receivers. Today, in an effort to expand the ministry of the Harbour Light, people all over the world can now listen via the Internet! The following document provides instructions for listening that should be adequate for most computers.

Equipment

The main requirement for listening is a fairly new computer with a broadband Internet connection. DSL or cable modem service provides the best link for listening to the Harbour Light. Dial-up connections may work, but are not recommended. Computer requirements are listed below.

Minimum

400MHz Pentium II
64MB RAM
10MB Hard Disk Space
16bit Sound Card
Windows 98 or later

Recommended

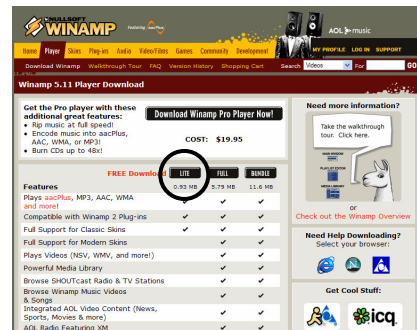
1GHz Pentium III
128MB RAM
10MB Hard Disk Space
Windows 2000 or later

Software

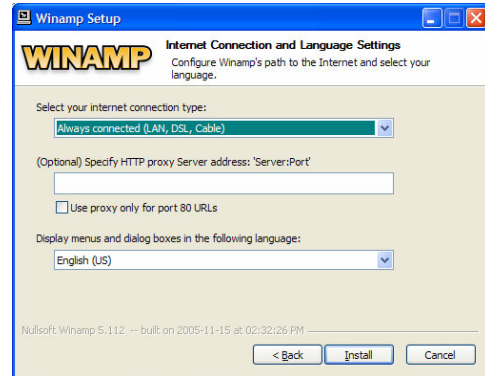
The Harbour Light Internet streaming broadcasts require listeners to use WinAmp lite software by Nullsoft. The program may be downloaded free from the Internet and then installed on your computer.

To download WinAmp lite software:

1. Establish your normal connection to the Internet.
2. Browse to <http://www.winamp.com/player/free.php> or
3. Browse to the Harbour Light site at <http://www.harbourlightradio.org/>. Open the Internet streaming page and click on the WinAmp lite link.
4. Click on the Free Download Lite icon.
5. Save the file to a folder on your computer. You may save it to the Desktop to find it easily.
6. Find the file and double-click on it. Your computer may display security warning messages. Click Run.
7. Review the license agreement and click I Agree.
8. Click Next at the Choose Components screen. Do not change any of the components unless you know the software very well.
9. Click Next at Choose File Location if you want the program to install in the C:\Program Files\Winamp folder. You may change the folder location by clicking Browse and choosing another location. Most will simply click Next to install the file in the C:\Program Files\Winamp folder.
10. Click Next at the Choose Install Options screen. Do not change any of the options unless you know the software very well.



11. Click Install at the Internet Connection and Language Setting screen if you are using LAN, DSL, or Cable.
12. Fill out the User information screen and click Send.
13. Click Run WinAmp. Note that the program adds an icon to your desktop for easy access. You may also open the program through the Windows start menu.

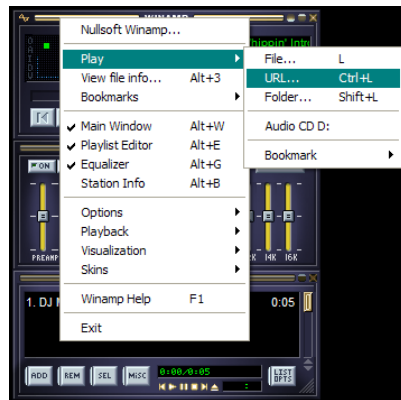
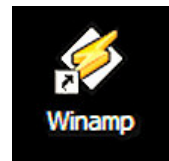


Listening

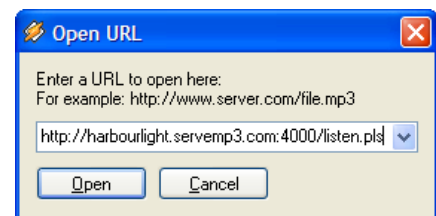
Listening requires a connection to the Internet, the WinAmp software, and the proper URL. The procedure is very easy.

To listen to the Harbour Light of the Windwards:

1. Start your computer.
2. Double-click on the WinAmp icon **or** choose Start|All Programs|WinAmp.
3. Place the cursor on the upper portion of the WinAmp skin and left-click to open the options menu. Choose Play and then URL. You may also press Control L.



4. Enter the following URL into the Open URL screen:

5. Click Open to listen.
